Placed in the heart of South America, the Pantanal forest extends over more than 250 thousand km² and shows Wildlife and Plants from several other Brazilian biomes such as cerrado, caatinga, Atlantic forest, and Amazon forest.

Protected as a National treasure by the 1988 Constitution, and a World Biosphere Reserve by the United Nations in 2000, it is the largest Floodplain Forest Area on the planet and is waiting for your visit.

The sunrise and sunset, with its macaws and parrots in flight, as well as the enchantments of nature will mark your trip through this natural paradise, where there are more than 650 species of birds, 80 species of mammals, and 263 types of fish.

For 5 days and 4 nights each, with 1 night on land and 3 nights sailing, in an all-inclusive drink and meals system on the comfortable Joicetur boats, The Paraguay River will take us to one of the most scenic regions in Brazil, the Pantanal of Corumbá.



Earth Route

Sailing towards the “Estrada Parque Pantanal” (Pantanal’s Park Road), this route provides passengers adventures and classic activities of the Pantanal region, such as a nightly spotting of alligators, a vehicle for a photo safari on the south Pantanal park road, with its remarkable biodiversity and old wooden bridges, an experience on a Pantanal ranch integrated to the ecosystem, horseback rides, trails and boat trips on the Paraguay and Paraguay mirim rivers, besides the morning and night sky view and energizing experience of a river bath in the middle of this natural patrimony of humanity that is the Pantanal.



Water Route

Sailing towards the Amolar Mountains Chain “Serra do Amolar”, this itinerary proposes the experience of getting to know the Pantanal through its flooded paths and the eyes of the true Pantanal’s men, with various tours and river safaris, it invites you to navigate through the majestic and imposing Serra do Amolar, enter the Pantanal National Park, and the Morro do Caracará to see the primitive inscriptions left by the first people of the Pantanal, to live and be enchanted with the riverside communities of the Paraguay River, and finally to energize yourself in the crystalline waters, with a river bath, amidst this ecological sanctuary.





Earth Route Itinerary

1º Day | Corumbá – Pantanal – Mato Grosso do Sul.

Arrival in the city of Corumbá and check-in at the Hotel Nacional starting at 2:00 pm. Free afternoon and night.

2º Day | Corumbá – Pantanal – Mato Grosso do Sul

After breakfast, we will check out of the Hotel Nacional at 8:00 am, and at 8:30 am we will leave for a historical-cultural circuit through the city of Corumbá. At 12h30 We end our activity with lunch, not included in the package, in a restaurant in the city center. At 2:00 pm we will board the selected Cruise Ship and at 3:00 pm we will start our navigation through the Paraguay River. At night, before dinner, around 7:00 pm, we will have a "chat" about the activities, and at 9:00 pm, we will leave for a special meeting with the alligators and the enchanting night sky of the Pantanal.

3º Day | Pantanal – "Estrada Parque Pantanal Sul" (South Pantanal Park Road)

At sunrise we will be anchored at the "Estrada Parque Pantanal Sul" (South Pantanal Park Road) (at Manga Port), the starting point for a land safari, on a wild road with diverse natural scenery, where adventure and fauna observation is frequent. Our tour ends at a Pantanal farm where we will have the option of riding or walking to observe a little more of the flora and fauna. At this same lodge we will have lunch which is included in our package, but with drinks paid separately, and at 1:30pm we return to the boat to enjoy the afternoon and an enchanting sunset. At night, before dinner, around 7:00 PM, we will exchange a "chat" about the day's activities.

4º Day | Pantanal – Paraguai-Mirim River

This day is dedicated to an immersion in the path of the Pantanal waters, discovering the secrets of the region through the rivers, affluents and corixos, the fauna, especially the aquatic habits birds and the flora. Navigation on the Paraguay-Mirim with its narrow margins allows for the observation of various birds and animals that have the river margin as their habitat, making up our river photo safari activity. In the clean water bays of the Paraguay-Mirim, we will stop for the energizing experience of a river bath in the midst of nature, but with all the comfort you deserve, it is also possible to practice kayaking that will be available, our activity ends with lunch and time to rest in the afternoon contemplating the Pantanal landscapes. At the end of the day we return to the river in our motor boats for a special sunset contemplation activity.

5º Day | Corumbá – Pantanal – Mato Grosso do Sul

At sunrise we will be anchored in the General Port of Corumbá. Wake up, organize your luggage, have a great breakfast. Our arrival will be right after breakfast.

Water Route Itinerary

1º DAY - CORUMBÁ – PANTANAL – MATO GROSSO DO SUL | BRAZIL

Arrival in the city of Corumbá and check in at the Hotel Nacional, from 2pm. Afternoon and free night.

2º DAY - CORUMBÁ & PARAGUAI RIVER

After breakfast, we will check out of the Hotel Nacional at 8:00 am, and at 8:30 am we will leave for a historical-cultural circuit through the city of Corumbá. At 10:30 am we will board the cruise ship, and start our navigation on the majestic Paraguay River with a cheerful lunch. Our afternoon is free, take the opportunity to rest, sunbathe, explore the boat or chat. Before dinner, around 7 pm, we will take a chat for the next day's schedule, together with our guides. Our dinner will be at 20:00.

3º DAY - SERRA DO AMOLAR & PANTANAL NATIONAL PARK

We will awaken to the incredible Pantanal sunrise with a delicious breakfast. Our morning will be dedicated to boating, hiking and kayaking through the majestic and incomparable Serra do Amolar, a sandstone hillside that extends for 80 kilometers on the Pantanal between Corumbá (MS), Cáceres (MT) and the border with Bolivia. A place that abounds with beauty and a lot of energy.

After the morning's activities we return to the boat for lunch. At 3:00 pm we will again navigate in our boats to the Pantanal National Park, where we will find records of the first civilizations of the Pantanal and a breathtaking view of the Pantanal plain inside de park. We will return to the boat, and at about 7:30pm we will have a chat about the next day's program. Our dinner will be at 8:00 pm

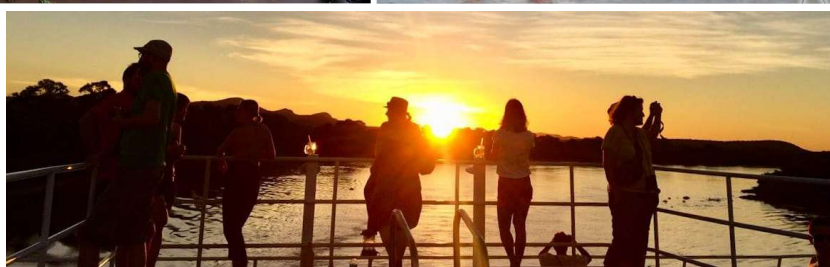
4º DAY - PARAGUAI MIRIM RIVER & CLEAR WATER COMMUNITY

On this day, the community and the crystal clear waters of Paraguay-Mirim welcome us with open arms. From 7:30 am we will sail in our boats, to get to know a little about the habits and knowledge of these people who lives in the inner Pantanal, the rich biodiversity of the Pantanal allow they to living on the bait scavenging, honey cultivation and learned to express themselves in the line and wood crafts. In the middle of the route we will stop for an energy bath in the crystal clear waters of Pantanal. And after the bath, a Riverside Family awaits us for a surprise lunch. Until 13:30 we return to the boat and our afternoon is free on board. At 4:30 pm, get ready for a lovely evening, we will sail in small boats until sunset, don't be late! At 8:00 pm, wear a very colorful outfit because we will have a closing dinner for the cruise.

5º DAY – CORUMBÁ

At sunrise we will be anchored in the General Port of Corumbá. Wake up, organize your luggage, have a great breakfast. Our arrival will be right after breakfast.

Comodoro Ship

The COMODORO hotel boat, with capacity for up to 30 passengers, offers 15 cabins with private panoramic balcony, equipped with twin or double beds, private bathroom and air conditioning. VIP Ship

The boat also offers 01 jacuzzi, bar, restaurant, social area with TV and 40hp motor boats for river rides.



Almirante Ship

The **ALMIRANTE** hotel boat, with capacity for up to 20 passengers, offers 6 cabins equipped with low beds and bunk beds, private bathroom, air conditioning, and 220v electricity. The boat also offers a leisure area with two decks, one below and one above with a jacuzzi, barbecue and shower, air-conditioned dining room, game room and social area with TV.

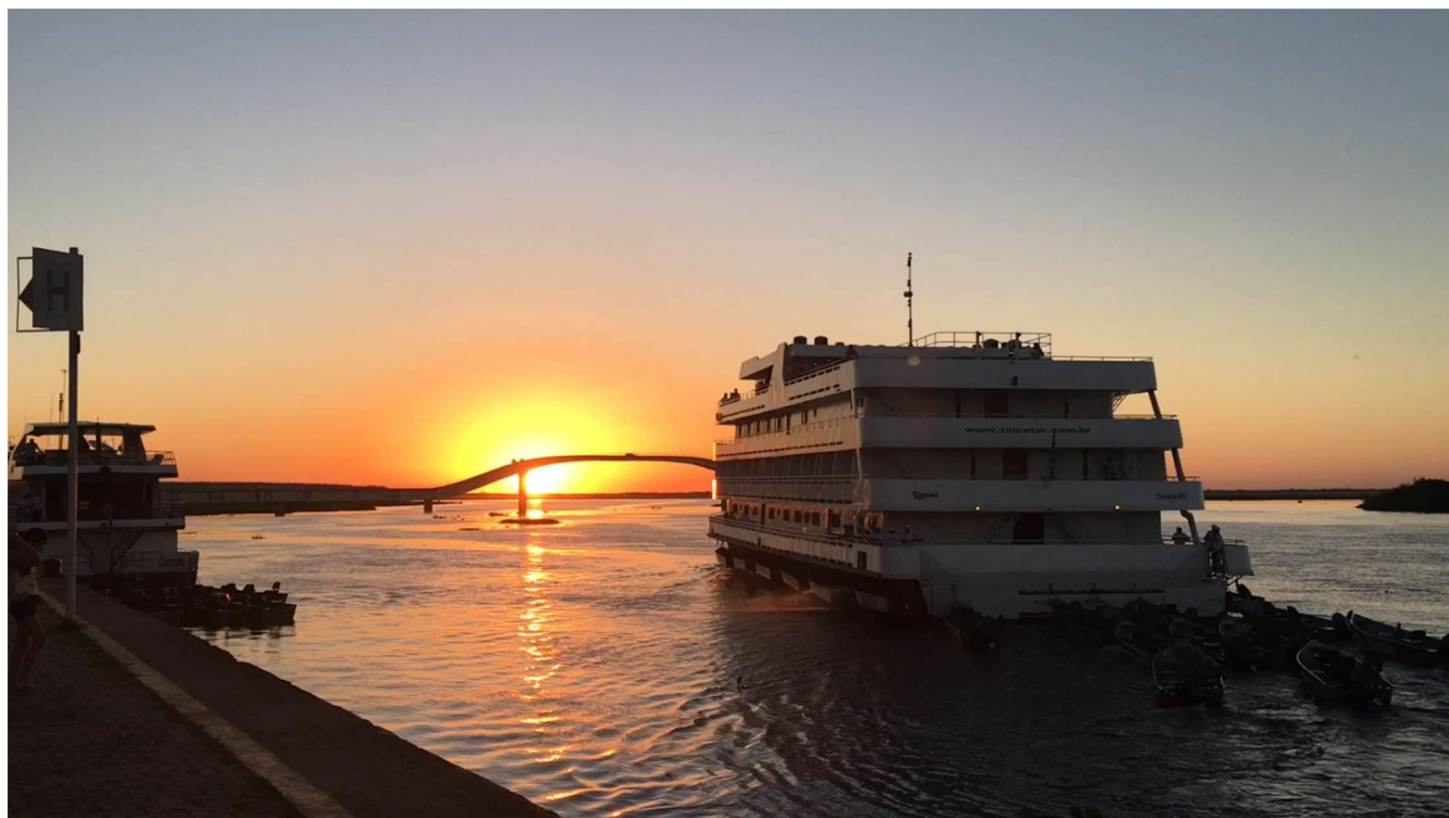
